<b>YEAR 1</b>	<b>CHC100</b>	<b>CYPRUS: HISTORY AND CULTURE</b>	<b>SEYİT ÖZKUTLU</b>
	Being able to comparatively analyse the variable dynamics of Cyprus across the ages also brings with it an understanding of the dynamics of the Mediterranean basin. Having information about the island of Cyprus and the Mediterranean culture provides us with an opportunity to understand and describe the states established in the Mediterranean, the religious communities operating there, and the socio-cultural interactions between people. This course offers the opportunity to examine in depth the social, economic and cultural dynamics of Cyprus, which acts as a bridge between East and West.		
<b>YEAR 2 GROUP A</b>	<b>GEC239</b>	<b>CRITICAL THINKING</b>	<b>ESEN SUCUOĞLU</b>
	In this course students will learn how to: critically read, listen, and write, separate bad information from good information, analyze arguments and construct cogent arguments, understand causal connections in systems develop intellectual and personal discipline.		
	<b>ARC301</b>	<b>ACADEMIC READING SKILLS</b>	<b>YASEMİN ÇETEREİŞİ</b>
This course helps students to develop their academic reading skills. A variety of texts will be used to develop students' academic reading skills. The texts cover topics related to different fields: Studying, travelling, health, education... The course provides opportunities for reading and sharing of information and the chance to read authentic and imaginary materials for pleasure and increased self-confidence as skilled and critical readers.

	<b>GEC337</b>	<b>ENGLISH READING SKILLS</b>	<b>ERAL AKARTÜRK</b>
	This course will use a variety of texts to develop students' academic reading skills. The textscover topics related to different fields: studying, travelling, health, education... The course provides opportunities for reading and sharing of information and the chance to read authentic and imaginary materials for pleasure and increased self-confidence as skilled andcritical readers.		
<b>YİT200</b>	<b>TURKISH FOR FOREIGNERS</b>	<b>TÜLAY KAYA</b>	
YİT is designed for students who have very little or no previous knowledge of Turkish grammar and vocabulary. The topics of the course will vary from the Turkish Alphabet to the present and continuous tenses, speech patterns, and grammer / vocabulary knowledge.			
<b>YEAR 4</b>	<b>DEC404</b>	<b>ADVANCED TECHNOLOGIES IN ENDODONTICS</b>	<b>ABDULLAH SEBAI</b>
	This course explains the last technologies developed in Endodontics field, the advanced devices and instruments for root canal treatment, and explains how to use these endodontic devices and instruments in the practical lessons. Students are allowed to learn how to overcome the complications and the disadvantages of the traditional root canal treatment's instruments by the advanced tools.		
	<b>DEC416</b>	<b>NANOTECHNOLOGY IN DENTISTRY</b>	<b>FATMA BASMACI</b>
The aim of this course is to give general and explanatory information about nanomaterials using biotechnology including tissue engineering and dental nano robots. It is aimed to mention the dental application areas of these nanomaterials as a result of research and development of materials and devices thanks to nanotechnology.			
<b>YEAR 5</b>	<b>DEC506</b>	<b>BASIC IMMUNOLOGY AND VACCINE STRATEGIES</b>	<b>CENK SERHAN ÖZVEREL</b>
	In this class, you will be reminded the basic principles of immunology and you will focus on how it interferes with current vaccination strategies.		
	<b>DEC514</b>	<b>TMJ DISORDERS AND MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING</b>	<b>GÜRKAN ÜNSAL</b>
In this elective course, the anatomy and diagnosis of the pathologies of temporomandibular joint disorders will be explored. Additionally, the role of magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) in diagnosing these disorders will be discussed. Participants will acquire the necessary knowledge and skills to understand jaw joint conditions and assess the diagnostic value of MRI.
