Models

- Frasaco Ag–3 (Original) Lower-Upper Jaws (2 Pcs)
- Frasaco Replacement Teeth (Original) varies by subcommittees see related subcommittee list.

Rotary Devices

- Micromotor + Micro-motor Arm
- Contra-angle hand-piece
- Burs for contra-angle varies by department see related department list

Hand Tools

- Diamond inverted cone bur (black or green) Diameter between 0.8–0.7 mm (diameter code 008– 007) - 3 pcs

- Cold cure acrylic (preferably transparent)

- Dental magnification loupes with light source (at least magnification x3) (Loupes use is recommended for a clear vision during procedures, but **NOT COMPULSARY**)

Extracted real teeth (decay free)

- Maxillary & Mandibular Anterior Teeth (Central, Lateral Incisors and Canine)
- Maxillary & Mandibular Premolars (Maxillary premolars should be two-rooted, Mandibular premolars single-rooted)
- Maxillary & Mandibular Molars (preferably not 3rd molars)

NOTE: Plastic model teeth with root canals, produced for endodontic purposes, are not recommended at all because they are expensive and do not imitate real teeth well, but will still be accepted for those who cannot find extracted real teeth.
