1. Purpose

2. Competition Theme

3. Participation Requirements

- Each Collegium (Auris, Nova, Orion, Zenith) can participate with a maximum of 5 students, with each student submitting one photograph.
- Collegiums may conduct their own pre-selection process to determine their 5 representatives.
- Photos can be taken with a professional camera or a smartphone camera.
- Al-generated or heavily manipulated images will not be accepted.
- Participants must submit both digital and printed versions of their photographs.
